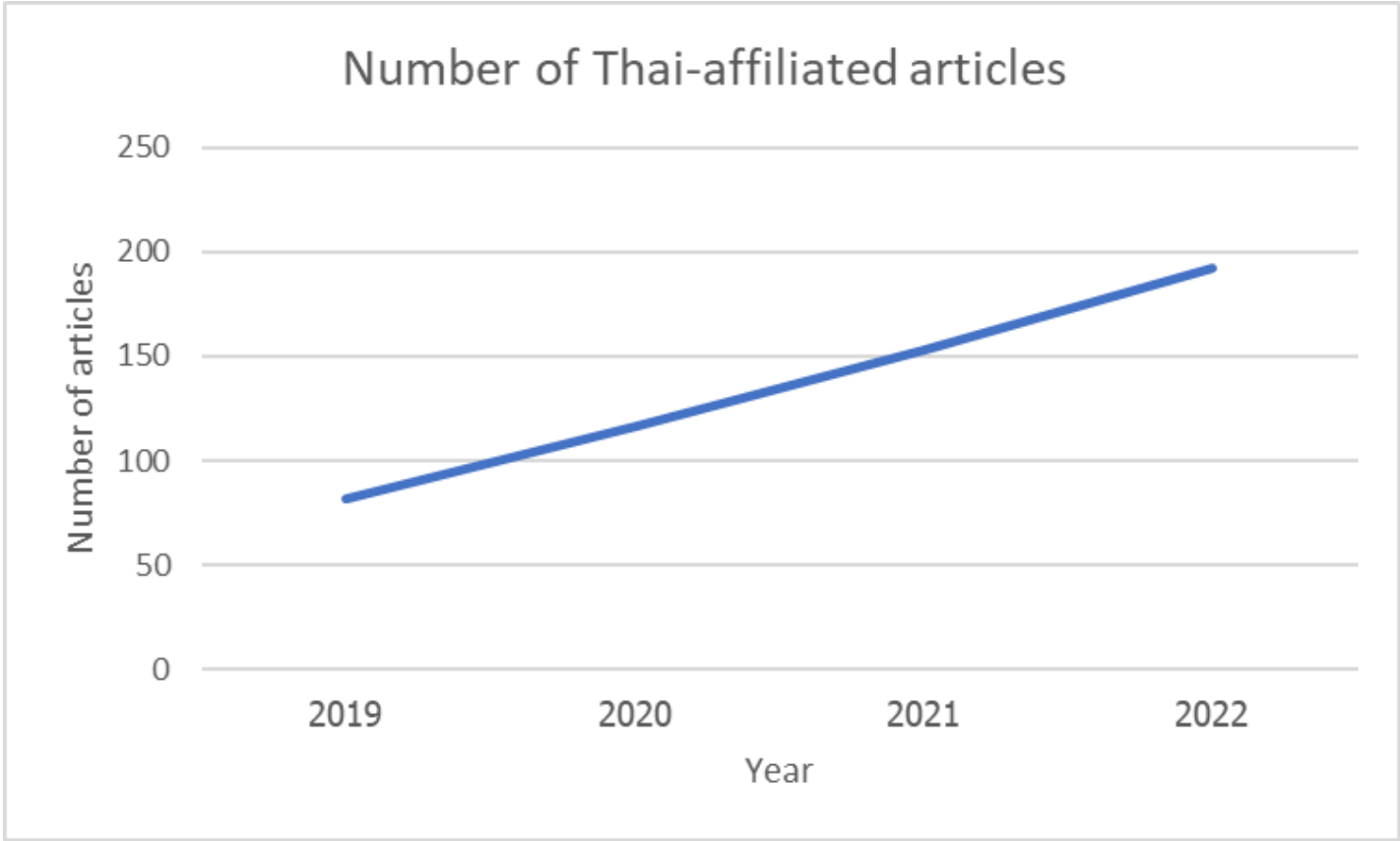

- Language education (364)

- Other (195)
 - Teacher trainers' beliefs about feedback on teaching practice
 - Exploring revisions in academic text

Citations of Thai AL research



- Articles 2019-2021
- Average number of citations/article: 2.9
- Average number of citations/article for top 50 journals: 10.0
- Average number of citations/article for others: 2.5
- Roughly 30% of articles have no citations

Getting published in a top journal and getting cited



- Think like a researcher, not a teacher
- Research is an attempt to **understand** something better through the systematic and formal collection and analysis of empirical data (Shanahan, 2002)
- Uncited articles
 - Effects of activity X on students' Y in context Z
 - Needs analysis

Comparing the effect of collaborative and individual prewriting on EFL learners' writing development

- NOT does collaborative or individual work better?
- Comparing different impacts of 2 approaches
 - Analytic ratings
 - Linguistic ratings

A new aspect on a fashionable topic



Teacher professional development to implement Global Englishes language teaching

- Trendiness of research into global Englishes/ELF
- Most work on attitudes; little work on how to change teachers

Focus on an under-researched idea with promise



The role of mindfulness in reducing English language anxiety among Thai college students

- Massive amount of research into anxiety
- Little research into mindfulness
- Linking anxiety and mindfulness provides directions for reducing anxiety

Conduct exemplary research

The antecedents of boredom in L2 classroom learning

- Nice title
- Comparing multiple theoretical perspectives
 - Environmental theories
 - Subjective theories
 - Environmental-subjective matches
- Multiple instruments
- Detailed founded analysis
- Key findings (9 antecedents of boredom) are readily comprehensible and actionable
